Soledad Demaria's work is a celebration of Latin American art and culture. The work displayed in *RT-VITRO*, named after the type of ink she incorporates into her pieces, looks like stained glass imagery of moments within the artist's life. Drawing inspiration from Latin culture like overbearing "abuelitas", literary imagery like fairies and her own heartbreak, Demaria fuses together a tapestry of colorful stained glass like works that are layered with metaphors for the viewer to get lost in.

ABOUT SOLEDAD DEMARIA

Soledad Demaria was born in Argentina on December 1, 1983. In spite of having a degree in economics, she always found herself immersed in an artistic atmosphere of some kind. After leaving her degree behind, Demaria embraced a career in art.

For Demaria, every day life and art is inseparable. In her paintings, she creates strange creatures from everyday objects and develops painting techniques that allow the unconscious to express itself. She works in Indian ink and intense colors.

Her work is particularly influences by artists such as Alberto Giacometti, Daniel Egneus, Eduardo Stupia, Andy Warhol and Gustav Klimt.
